

A Chronology of End Time Events

As Recorded

In the

Book of Revelation

The Book of Revelation is a written record of what will occur at the end of the church age. The revelation of these end-time events was given to the Apostle John in a series of visions. Actually, John repeatedly said that "*I saw...*". It is not clear if John was shown the things recorded in the Book of Revelation in a series of what we would commonly call *visions* or whether John was actually transported through time and observed the things he wrote. In any case, the Book of Revelation is a record of end-time events which will surely happen as the church age closes.

The Book of Revelation is complex and confusing, and cannot be casually read. It must be studied carefully with the help of the Holy Spirit. The things which John saw were faithfully recorded and set down as he saw them unfold before his eyes. The problem which arises is that the Revelation Record is not a lock-stepped, chronological manuscript. John first sees a vision of sequential events which span the entire tribulation period (the 6 seals), and is then shown a series of visions which provide details of this first vision.

This literary structure is not uncommon in the books of the bible. If the Book of Daniel is read as set down in the Holy Scriptures, the story of how Daniel was captured in Jerusalem and brought to Babylon is in Daniel 1. After a few years, Daniel is called to interpret a dream for King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon. In this dream, he saw a gigantic image of a warrior. The pieces of this image represented the different nations that would rule over and persecute Israel from when the image was shown to Nebuchadnezzar until the 2cd advent of Jesus Christ. The anatomical parts of this image represented kingdoms which would arise and fall over the next 2600 years (Daniel 2). These kingdoms were not specifically identified until much later (Chapters 7-11). For example, the head of the image was the Babylonian Empire, the arms were the Medo-Persian Empire..... down to the 10 toes which would be a 10-nation confederacy that would be the final empire to rule over Israel and persecute the Jewish people. As one reads through the Book of Daniel, there are more details given to Daniel (and us) by visiting angels as to who would rule over these future nations, what significant events would occur during their reign, etc.

The Book of Revelation is written in the same literary structure. John first experiences seeing the risen Christ, and then God's throne in heaven. He is then told to record 7 letters to 7 churches in Asia (minor). After this, he is called up to heaven where he is shown end-time events as recorded in a large scroll sealed with 7 seals. The contents of the scroll cannot be revealed until the 7 seals are broken (removed). Roman manuscripts in John's time were often sealed with a single seal; only very important manuscripts were closed with multiple seals. As the 7 seals are broken (removed) by Christ, John is shown conditions or events

which will occur over the entire tribulation period of 1260 days. Once the seals are removed, the scroll is read by Jesus Christ and more details of the 7-seal overview are shown to John as 7 trumpets sound in heaven one by one, followed by 7 vials/bowls which are successively poured out upon the earth. Between the 7 trumpets and the 7 bowls are details of things which will occur over this same period of time. The reader should now clearly recognize that this is exactly the same structure as the ancient Book of Daniel.

This short document will list the events which were recorded by the Apostle John in the *chronological order* in which they occur. This chronology is fully explained in **The Book of Revelation:** *Mysteries Revealed.* The complete chronological scriptural record is given with descriptive narratives in **The Book of Revelation:** *Compiled in Chronological Order.* The structure of the entire Book of Revelation as recorded by John is given to John by Christ in Revelation 1:19.





The Book of Revelation In Chronological Order Scriptural Record



Prologue and a Salutation.....Revelation 1: 1-8

- [1] The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John:
- [2] Who bare record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw.
- [3] Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.
- [4] John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;
- [5] And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of

the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

[6] And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever.

Amen.

[7] Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

[8] I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.



Instructions to John.....Rev 1:9-11

[9] I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

[10] I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

[11] Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

John sees the Risen Christ......Rev 1:12-20

- [12] And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;
- [13] And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.
- [14] His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;
- [15] And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.
- [16] And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.
- [17] And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:
- [18] I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.
- [19] Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter;
- [20] The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.
