



A Chronology of End Time Events

As Recorded In the

Book of Revelation

The Book of Revelation is not sequential in structure. There are three keys necessary to understanding a correct timesequenced chronology. The *first key* is to recognize that the 7 seals are not sequentially linked to the 7 trumpets and 7 bowl judgments. The 7 seals provide an overview of conditions and that will exist and several key events which will take place during the Tribulation Period. The second key is that the Tribulation period is not 7 years' long, but only 1260 days or about 3.5 years in duration. The 7 bowl judgments are sequentially followed by the 7 Bowl Judgments: Both span the entire Tribulation Period and define a time of great persecution, trial and testing. Finally, the third key is to understand that the Book of Revelation compiled by John the revelator is a literary bifid. The bifid involves Chapters 9-11 compared to Chapters 12-14. Chapters 9-11 provide a broad description of what happens when the 7 Trumpets sound: Chapters 12-14 give many details of what is happening just prior to the 7 trumpet judgments and during this same period of time. The following graphic depicts the sequential progression in the Book of Revelation with the literary bifid. Other OT books with this structure are Isaiah, Ezekiel, Daniel, and Zechariah.



The 7 trumpet judgments bring terrible conditions upon both the earth and mankind, but the 7 bowl judgments bring unprecedented and catastrophic events upon both the earth and mankind. Careful study of the meaning and purpose of the tribulation period will show that the 7 Trumpet judgments parallel the *Wrath of Satan* upon the earth and its inhabitants; while the 7 Bowls or Vials (KJV) are the Wrath of God upon Satan and his followers. In the companion book *Revelation: Mysteries Revealed*, it is shown that the 7 trumpets are sounded over a 1245 day period of time, and the 7 Bowls of God's Wrath are poured out over a short period of time; only 15 days. The total period of tribulation is 1260 days.

Outline of the Book of Revelation

- The book begins with a *salutation and Vision of Christ* in Chapter 1.
- Chapters 2 and 3 contain 7 *Letters* to 7 *Churches*.
- Chapter 4 contains a Vision of God's Throne in heaven.
- Chapter 5 is an *interlude*, in which a scroll that contains the Revelation Record is kept by God and opened by Christ.

Tribulation Period Overview: The 7 Seals

Chapters 6 and 7 are concerned with removing the 7 *seals* from the scroll. As each of Seals 1-6 is removed (Chapter 6), conditions that exist during the Tribulation period are revealed. In *Revelation: Mysteries Revealed* (Phillips) it is shown that the Tribulation Period is not 7 years in duration, but 3.5 years/1260 days. The Tribulation period of 3.5 years is identical to the period of time during which the 7 *trumpet judgments* (Wrath of Satan) take place and the 7 bowls / vials (Wrath of God) are poured out upon Satan and his followers.

- Chapter 7 contains two events which will take place *before* the Wrath of God (the 7 bowls) take place: (1) 144,000 *redeemed Jewish Christians* will be sealed from God's Wrath... they will populate the millennial kingdom. (2) A great multitude is shown in heavens which are the *raptured and resurrected saints*.
- As Chapter 8 begins, the 7th seal is opened and the 3.5 year tribulation period is about to be revealed to John the revelator. The following period of time is so devastating and important to God's plan for the

earth that all of heaven is stunned and there is silence for *about half an hour* (Rev 8:1).

• As 7 angels prepare to sound, a remarkable revelation takes place. We are told that the *prayers* of all the saints are kept in heaven before the throne of God. A censer is thrown from earth to heaven and there are thunders, lightnings and an earthquake. The Tribulation period is about to commence (Rev 8:1-6).

The 7 Trumpet Judgments

- Rev 8:1-13, 9:1-21, 11:15-19. The 7 *Trumpets sound* sequentially: They span 1250 days of the 1260 day tribulation period.
- The *Rapture* occurs at the Blowing of the 7th Trumpet (Rev 11:15-19), which also initiates the *Wrath of God*.... The 7 Bowls.
- The *Wedding of the Lamb* (Jesus Christ) will take place in heaven following the *Bema Seat Judgment* of all believers (Rev 19:1-10).

The 7 Bowl/Vial Judgments

As the Wedding of the Lamb and the Bema Seat Judgment take place in heaven: The Wrath of God is poured out upon the Earth. The pouring out of the 7 *Bowls* devastates planet earth and brings unprecedented destruction. The Bowls are poured out between when the 7th Trumpet sounds on The Jewish *Feast of Trumpets* (Tishri 1) and the Jewish *Feast of Atonement/Yom Kippur* on Tishri 10.

• The first 6 vials/bowls are poured out in rapid succession over a 10 day period (Rev 15-16).

- The 7th Bowl (Rev 19:11-21) brings two major events
 - *Babylon*, the *Commercial and Religious center of Satan* is destroyed (Rev 17-18).
 - The 2cd Advent of Christ takes place at the Battle of Armageddon (Rev 19: 1-21)

The Millennial Kingdom and Eternity

- *Satan* is bound for 1000 years in the bottomless Pit (Rev 20:1-2)
- The *Antichrist* and the *False Prophet* are thrown into the *Lake of Fire and Brimstone* (Rev 20:1-3)
- The *Martyrs* are rewarded (Rev 20:4-6)
- The 1000 year *Millennial Kingdom* takes place (Rev 20:7-9)
- Satan is released, and the earth is cleansed of him and his followers at the last great battle begin good and evil (Rev 20:10-15)
- The *Great White Throne* judgment takes place (Rev 20:7-15)
- The *Earth* is renovated (Rev 21:1)
- *Eternity* begins (Rev 21:2-27)

This book will list the events which were recorded by the Apostle John in the *chronological order* in which they occur. This chronology is fully explained in **The Book of Revelation:** *Mysteries Revealed*. The complete chronological scriptural record is given with descriptive narratives in **The Book of Revelation:** *Compiled in Chronological Order*. The structure of the entire Book of Revelation as recorded by John is given to John by Christ in Revelation 1:19.

Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter

The Biblical record is cross referenced to the 30 Book Chapters by **Red Chapter References.** For example, read the **Preface** and **Overview** sections of **Revelation**: Mysteries Revealed now. The following chronological sequence of events is recorded in the Book of Revelation.



The Book of Revelation In Chronological Order *Scriptural Record*

We will now present the Revelation Record from the King James Bible in the Chronological sequence that it occurs, with relevant comments. This Chronology is meant to complement and accompany the book: *Revelation: Mysteries Revealed* by Don T. Phillips.



Chapter 1

John is a Roman political prisoner who has been exiled to the Island of Patmos off the coast of Asia (Minor). He was *in the spirit* praying one day around 93 AD when *God* came to him.

Revelation 1:1-8

[1] The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John:

[2] Who bare record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw.

[3] Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

[4] John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;

[5] And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

[6] And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

[7] Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.
[8] I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

Instructions to John

From the context, a period of time.... likely short... would pass after God addresses John. John is *in the spirit on the Lord's day* when he hears a *voice like a trumpet* speaking to him: It is the voice of the resurrected Jesus Christ.

Revelation 1:9-11

[9] I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

[10] I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

[11] Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.



John Sees the Risen Christ

John has been told in Rev 1:11 that he was to write *what thou seest; write it in a book;* and *send it to the 7 churches in Asia.* As John hears this voice, he turned to see our Lord Jesus Christ in all of His heavenly glory.

Revelation 1:12-16

[12] And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;

[13] And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

[14] His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;

[15] And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.
[16] And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

John's Reaction and the Sovereignty of Jesus Christ

John is overwhelmed when he sees the risen Christ, and he falls at His feet as if he was dead. The majesty of Christ in this instance has been painted by many great artists, but no combination of artist, paints and brush can capture the majesty of our lord and savior. Seeing John's reaction, Christ addresses Him and us; *fear not.* Every Christian should fall upon their knees at this statement. We may go through ridicule, rejection, trials and tribulation... but Christ assures us... *fear not.* There is no fear in living for Jesus Christ and following after Him.

Revelation 1: 17-20

[17] And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:

[18] I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

[19] Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter;
[20] The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The

seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.
